WHAT IS LEQVIO?

LEQVIO (inclisiran) is an injectable prescription medicine used along with diet and exercise to reduce low-density lipoprotein (LDL-C) or "bad" cholesterol in adults with high blood cholesterol levels called hypercholesterolemia (including a type of high cholesterol called heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia [HeFH]).

Understanding the connection between bad cholesterol (LDL-C) and heart disease

A common type of heart disease is called atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease, or ASCVD. It is caused by consistent high levels of bad cholesterol in the blood that can lead to the buildup of plaque in your arteries.

Plaque buildup can cause serious problems, like:

- Heart attack
- Stroke
- Blockages within the arteries, causing chest pain

It is not known if LEQVIO® can decrease problems related to high levels of bad cholesterol, such as heart attacks or stroke.

Start by knowing your bad cholesterol number

If you're not sure of your cholesterol number, ask your doctor. The expert-recommended goal for bad cholesterol is less than 70 mg/dL, and it may be reasonable to target below 55 mg/dL for some people.

These results are based on a study in which 1561 patients with atherosclerotic cardiovascular disease (ASCVD) were on a maximally tolerated statin with or without another cholesterollowering treatment—in addition to LEQVIO (781 patients) or a placebo (780 patients). Cholesterollevels were measured at the start of the study and compared with cholesterollevels 17 months later. Sixty percent of the patients were 65 years or older. LEQVIO was also studied in a similar clinical trial of 1617 patients with similar results.




