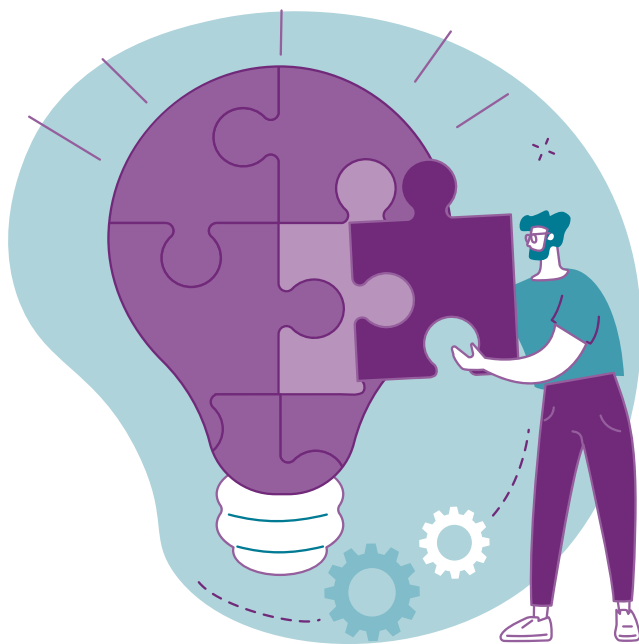
We've developed these engaging activities to stimulate your mind. Furthermore, you'll find tips and reminders around ways to help keep bad cholesterol at bay, including:

IMPORTANT SAFETY INFORMATION

Do not use if you have had an allergic reaction to LEQVIO (inclisiran) or any of its ingredients.

Serious allergic reactions can occur. Seek medical help right away if you have difficulty breathing or swallowing; swelling of the face, lips, tongue or throat; dizziness and feel faint; decrease in blood pressure; severe skin itching, with a red rash or raised bumps.

The most common side effects of LEQVIO were: injection site reaction (including pain, redness, and rash), joint pain, and chest cold.

These are not all the possible side effects of LEQVIO. Ask your health care provider for medical advice about side effects. You are encouraged to report negative side effects of prescription drugs to the FDA.

What is LEQVIO?

LEQVIO is an injectable prescription medicine used along with diet and exercise to reduce low-density lipoprotein (LDL-C) or "bad" cholesterol in adults with high blood cholesterol levels called hypercholesterolemia (including a type of high cholesterol called heterozygous familial hypercholesterolemia [HeFH]).

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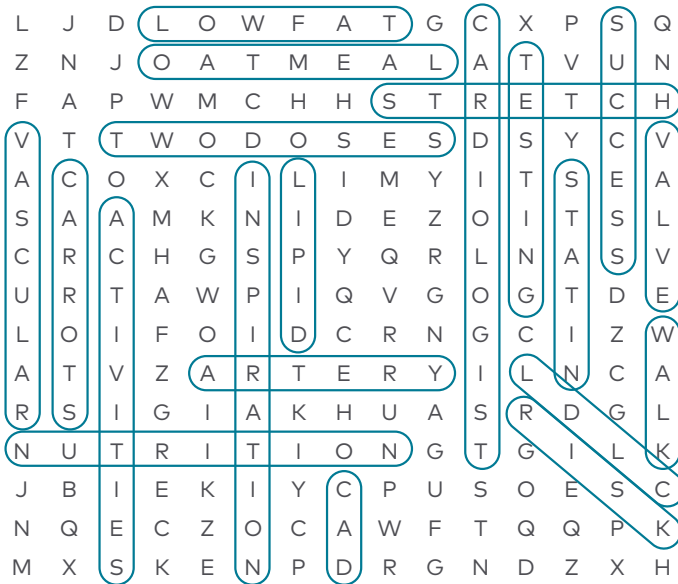
