The Co-Pay Plus offer may help you pay for your KISQALI including refills. The Co-Pay Plus offer is not health insurance but can help cover out-of-pocket expenses related to your prescription.

- ▶ Your annual benefit limit automatically resets every year. There's no need to sign up again.
- ▶ Offer only for those who are eligible and privately insured.

Start KISQALI at no cost, if you're eligible

With **the KISQALI Bridge Program**, if you are privately insured and eligible, you can get **up to 5 months** of KISQALI and/or FEMARA (including generic letrozole) for free while insurance coverage is pursued.[†]

†The Bridge Program applies to KISQALI and the KISQALI FEMARA Co-Pack only. Eligible patients must have private insurance, a valid prescription for KISQALI or the KISQALI FEMARA Co-Pack, and a denial of insurance coverage based on a prior authorization requirement. Program requires the submission of a prior authorization and/or appeal of the coverage denial within the first 90 days of enrollment to remain eligible. Program provides KISQALI for free to eligible patients for up to 5 months, or until they receive insurance coverage approval, whichever occurs earlier. A valid prescription consistent with FDA-approved labeling is required. Program is not available to patients whose medications are reimbursed in whole or in part by Medicare, Medicaid, TRICARE, or any other federal or state program. Patients may be asked to reverify insurance coverage status during the course of the program. No purchase necessary. Making sense of insurance terms

Insurance terms can feel confusing. Let's break them down.



Out-of-pocket costs: Health care expenses you're responsible for paying. They're not reimbursed by your insurance provider.



Deductible: What you pay for a prescription before your health plan starts covering the costs.

Example: With a **\$1,000 deductible** and a **\$2,000 bill, you'll pay \$1,000** and hit your deductible. Then, your health plan will cover the rest, other than any copayment for which you are responsible.



Co-pay/Co-insurance: A fixed amount (co-pay) or a percentage (co-insurance) that you pay for a prescription and/or medical service.

Example: With a medication that **costs \$100, you'll pay \$20**. Your health plan will cover the rest.[‡]

[‡]Your actual coverage will depend on your type of insurance and health plan.



Co-pay offer: Financial support from your medication's manufacturer for privately insured individuals. It aims to reduce out-of-pocket costs.
